REVIEW/APPROVAL OF THE JUNE 2016 MEETING MINUTES – MS. MATHESON

THE JUNE MINUTES WERE REVIEWED. AS THERE WERE NO ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS FROM THE GROUP A MOTION TO APPROVE WAS MADE BY MS. RUBIN AND SECONDED BY MR. VOSKUHL. THE MOTION CARRIED.

OTHER ITEMS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIR/DIRECTOR

MR. LEWIS REMINDED THE GROUP REGARDING THE OCBF SHARED PLAN. AN EXTENSION WAS APPLIED FOR AND APPROVED UNTIL MID-DECEMBER DUE TO OUR NOT HAVING 3 PARENT REPRESENTATIVES. OUR HOPE IS TO BRING THE SHARED PLAN TO THIS GROUP AT THE SEPTEMBER MEETING FOR APPROVAL AS WE NEED TO SUBMIT IT TO THE STATE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

MS. MATHESON INQUIRED IF THERE WAS ANYTHING THIS GROUP COULD DO TO HELP RECRUIT FAMILIES OR IF THERE WERE FAMILIES THAT ARE ALREADY BEING TARGETED FOR FAMILY INVOLVEMENT? MR. LEWIS WAS OPEN TO SUGGESTIONS OF FAMILIES HE MIGHT SPEAK WITH. HE STATED HE WOULD BE SPEAKING WITH FAMILIES THAT ARE ALREADY INVOLVED WITH HIGH FIDELITY WRAP AROUND. HE ALSO FELT THAT GRANDPARENTS OF CHILDREN INVOLVED WITH THE SYSTEMS OF CARE WOULD BE GOOD CANDIDATES. MS. CORDELL ADDED THAT THE FUNDING FOR THIS COMES TO \$16,000 WHICH GOES IMPORTANT TO OUR ADMIN FUND.

DISCUSSION CONTINUED ON THE DIFFERENT SYSTEMS WE MAY BE ABLE TO DRAW FROM.

DR. MAYER ANNOUNCED THAT THEY JUST RECEIVED WORD FROM THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION SERVICES THAT THERE IS ADDITIONAL FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR RESPITE CARE UP TO AGE 21. THE TOTAL AMOUNT IS \$17,455. THESE FUNDS CAN BE TAPPED IN TO FIRST SAVING OUR LOCAL RESOURCES.

MS. STREITER INQUIRED IF AT THE NEXT STEERING MEETING THEY COULD SPEND SOME TIME DEFINING WHAT THE ROLE OF THIS GROUP IS INDIVIDUALLY AS WELL AS COLLECTIVELY AND THEN DEFINING WHAT SOME LONG TERM GOALS WOULD BE.
