Robin Heise, Director of Records & Archives, came before the Board with an award recently received by the Department. Ms. Heise said the Records Center and Archives received the 2016 National Association of Government Archives & Records Administrators (NAGARA) Program Excellence Award for their educational outreach program.

The program was implemented in 2015 and was the first of its kind in the state, she said. Educators and students benefit from the program that focuses on local history found in the records of the archives center. There is a classroom component as well as online resources. It has become a model for other government repositories across the state, Ms. Heise said.

The NAGARA Program Excellence Award recognizes outstanding, innovative and successful programs or initiatives established at government records centers and archives.

Paul Newman, Sr., came before the Board to say that he and his family could not be more proud of Paul Newman, Jr., and all he has accomplished since coming back to Greene County. Mr. Newman Sr., was the Executive Director for the Fairborn Chamber of Commerce before retiring. He thanked the County for its interest in him for this development position.
