

## Joshua Baldwin Indicted for Burglary

(BEAVERCREEK, OHIO) – Greene County Prosecuting Attorney Stephen K. Haller announced that a Grand Jury has indicted Joshua Baldwin for Felonious Assault.

On May 28, 2017, Beavercreek Police were dispatched to a residence on Indian Ripple. A verbal altercation turned physical, with Baldwin punching another with a closed fist in the jaw, causing him to drop and his head to strike the pavement. The assault resulted in significant injuries to the victim. Joshua Baldwin, 34, is charged with one count of Felonious Assault as a result.

Joshua Baldwin is scheduled to appear for arraignment on August 4, 2017.
