

Greene County Jury Returns Verdict of Guilt in Aggravated Burglary Case

(GREENE COUNTY, OHIO) – On Thursday, August 31, 2017, a Greene County Jury found Jevon Russell, Jr. guilty of one count of Aggravated Burglary with a gun specification.

The case started with a late night 911 call made as a result of an armed Jevon Russell, Jr. breaking into a home in Fairborn with a companion, demanding to know the whereabouts of a former associate. While inside the home, Russell, Jr. stole hunting knives and a wallet, and advised that he would be putting a bullet through the former associate's head when he found him. In the course of the criminal investigation, Fairborn Police officers recovered the handguns that were used in the robbery and identified the two individuals responsible for this violent offense.
